Dedham Savings Foundation Supports Golf Tourney to Benefit School Enrichment Programs

(Dedham, MA) With the backdrop of the Dedham Golf and Polo Club, approximately 200 people assembled to take part in the 25th annual Community and School Resource Golf Tournament sponsored by the Dedham Police Department on August 27, 2012.
